Robert H. Doherty is the State President for New Jersey for Bank of America. As State President, he is responsible for focusing and integrating the Bank's local resources to increase sales penetration and provide community outreach and leadership within the New Jersey market. To accomplish this, Mr. Doherty leads a team of leaders representing every Bank of America line of business in New Jersey. In addition to his duties as State President, he is an Executive Vice President and co-leader for Bank of America's Commercial Group in New Jersey as the Products Delivery Manager responsible for the delivery of debt products to middle market and business banking clients.

Mr. Doherty joined Bank of America's predecessor bank, Fleet Bank, in December of 2002, as the Executive Vice President in charge of the bank's Middle Market operations in New Jersey. Prior to joining Fleet, Mr. Doherty spent twelve years at Wells Fargo / Wachovia Bank and its predecessor banks. At Wachovia, Mr. Doherty served as Senior Vice President and Commercial Banking Director responsible for middle market lending in six northern New Jersey counties. In addition to this role, Mr. Doherty held a variety of management positions in both the middle and large corporate markets. Prior to joining Wachovia in 1991, he was employed by Citibank and Bankers Trust Company.

Mr. Doherty holds an M.B.A. in finance and marketing from Columbia University's Graduate School of Business and earned a B.A. in Economics from Lafayette College in Easton, Pennsylvania.

Mr. Doherty currently serves on a number of boards and is involved in a number of charitable organizations in New Jersey. These include the New Jersey State Chamber of Commerce and its Executive Committee, The Community FoodBank of New Jersey, the Newark Museum, the corporate advisory board for the Boys & Girls Club in New Jersey, and the New Jersey Performing Arts Center's Business Partners Committee. Most recently he was selected as one of 15 founding members of Choose NJ, a nonprofit created by the state's business community to market, promote and facilitate business attraction, expansion and retention in the state. In the past, he has also been involved with the Morris County New Jersey Chamber of Commerce, the Morris Business Cabinet, Opportunity Newark, the Boy Scouts Patriots Path Council, the Newark Regional Business Partnership, the American Cancer Society, the New Jersey Bankers Association, the Chatham Education Foundation and the United Way.

Mr. Doherty is a life-long New Jersey resident. He and his wife, Gay, and their three sons live in Chatham, New Jersey and his sons attend Duke University, Cornell University and the Delbarton School respectively.
