



## **Greg Lalevee**

Greg Lalevee worked his way through the ranks of IUOE Local 825, beginning as a licensed crane operator, working as a union organizer and Business Representative. Lalevee was elected Local's Business Manager in 2010.

Under his leadership, Local 825 orchestrated several changes and transactions to strengthen the union's financial footing, consolidate its membership, establish a new labor-management coalition, while taking every opportunity to relentlessly pursue job opportunities for his members in the face of a weak economy.

In May 2011, Lalevee was named to the International Union's General Executive Board. In June 2011, Governor Chris Christie selected him as his nominee to the state Transportation Trust Fund Authority. He also sits on the State of N.J.
